

*The Village of Frankfort is entering into the final phase of its comprehensive wastewater treatment consolidation program. This last phase consists of demolishing the Village's north and west wastewater treatment plants (located near Walker Intermediate School in Frankfort Square and along Colorado Avenue in the Village of Frankfort, respectively) along with construction of a new excess flow storage pond at the north plant location. Once complete, these improvements will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in the Village of Frankfort, Frankfort Square, and the Hickory Creek Watershed by eliminating obsolete wastewater treatment facilities and providing additional excess flow storage capacity. These improvements are financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.*
