## Frankfort Identifies Streets for Resurfacing

At the April 8, 2009 Department of Operations committee meeting, members approved the 2009 street resurfacing program for the Village of Frankfort. Bids for the project had been submitted for review with the recommendation to award the bid to Iroquois Paving at \$459,809.45. Funds had been budgeted for this resurfacing program. The recommendation needs the approval of the Village Board at the April 27, 2009 board meeting to proceed.

Over two miles of Village streets are part of the resurfacing project. The locations to be resurfaced include:

- 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue – from Route 30 to Plank Trail
- Heritage Drive
- Hickory Street
- Kansas Street West - from Maple Street to the Cul-de-Sac
- Pembroke Drive
- Pembroke Court
- St. Francis Road – 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue to east of 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- West Bowen Avenue
- 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue – Sauk Trail to Laraway

Residents will be notified prior to any resurfacing. The Frankfort Public Works Department will provide construction supervision for the project. Locations are evaluated and reviewed each year to insure the continued quality of the streets throughout the community. The planned resurfacing of Sauk Trail from Pfeiffer Road to Harlem Avenue meets the complex federal requirements for stimulus funding.

“It’s important that our streets are evaluated for repairs and continue to be safe for our residents. This ongoing program provides the necessary information to plan ahead for resurfacing and budget responsibly to provide the services our residents demand”, commented Frankfort’s Mayor Jim Holland.

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
