Village Will Host Electric Aggregation Informational Meeting

The Village of Frankfort will be hosting an informational public meeting with residents to discuss the March 20 referendum regarding proposed electric aggregation. The public meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 8 at 7:30 PM at Grand Prairie School cafeteria, 10480 W. Nebraska Street in Frankfort. A formal presentation will be provided regarding the electric aggregation program.

In addition, an informal "Open House" is scheduled for Wednesday, February 29 from 4:00 to 8:00 PM at the Village Administration Office, 432 W. Nebraska for information regarding the electric aggregation program.

Illinois state laws allow communities to combine or aggregate small business and residential electricity. The primary purpose of aggregation is to create an opportunity to negotiate lower electric rates than Commonwealth Edison charges. The law requires voters to approve a referendum on the subject before the village can proceed. On November 21, 2011, the Frankfort Village Board unanimously approved a resolution that will place the measure on the March 20 ballot.

"At this meeting, it is our intention to provide information and respond to questions from our residents regarding the proposed aggregation program so that they can make an informed decision on the March ballot," commented Mayor Jim Holland.
